Learn more about the legendary Christmas Truce and visit Passchendaele, home to the best WWI Museum in Belgium. Visit Langemark German Cemetery and German second line trenches at Bayernwald. See the grave of Nelly Spindler, the only woman buried at Lijssenthoek Cemetery among 10,000 servicemen.

ITINERARY

Day **1**

Ypres Messines Nine Elms Cemetery Lijssenthoek Poperinge Ypres

Pick up from your Ypres hotel at 9.00, visit the New Zealand Memorial to the Missing at the Messines Ridge British Cemetery. The memorial lists 827 officers and men of the New Zealand Expeditionary Force with no known grave who died in or near Messines in 1917 and 1918. See the visitor centre and then stop at the statue of the New Zealand soldier in the centre of the town, a memorial to all New Zealand soldiers who fought in the battle of Messines Ridge. See the crypt under the church in Messines where Hitler was treated as a wounded soldier, and stand where Samuel Frickelton, a soldier in the New Zealand Military Forces, won his Victoria Cross.

After lunch, visit the Nine Elms Cemetery where David Gallaher, a captain of the "Original All Blacks" is buried.

Stop at Lijssenthoek, the location of a field hospital from 1915 until 1920, See the visitor centre and the cemetery containing 10,000 burials. See the grave of Nelly Spindler, a staff nurse buried with full military honours, and the only woman buried in this cemetery.

Visit Talbot House in Poperinge, "The Every Man's Club", a quiet place where soldiers could go to have a cup of tea or relax in the garden. Then, see the old Death Cells in the Town Hall. A sobering reminder of fate faced by many so-called 'deserters' during the Great War.

On the road back to Ypres, we'll visit the Chinese Memorial.

Overnight stay at the **Albion Hotel** in a Classic Room.

Lunch



Ypres Bayernwald Kemmel Passendale Polygon Wood Ypres

Departing after breakfast at 9.00am, we drive to **Bayernwald**, a set of German second line trenches in the sector of Wijtschate. The site consists of two mine galleries, a mine shaft, a trench system and five bunkers. It is accessed via a footpath which passes through the restored network of trenches.

Next, move on to Kemmel and stand at the **Spanbroekmolen Crater**, also known as the "Lone Tree Crater" and the "Pool of Peace", one of the remains of the Battle of Messines. Stop at the American Memorial of Kemmel and visit the Lettenberg Bunkers. Stand at the French Ossuary and the Angel on Kemmel Ridge.

After lunch, driving towards Zonnebeke and Passendale, to visit Tyne Cot Military Cemetery and Memorial. It is the CWGC largest cemetery in Europe. From Tyne Cot, travel to Gravenstafel where Gallaher was killed during the battle of Passendale. Visit the German Cemetery in Langemark and then on to Polygon Wood see the Memorial dedicated to the 1st Australian Division and the New Zealand Memorial.

In Ypres see the Menin Gate, the main square, the Cloth Hall (entry not included), the Cathedral and enjoy some free time before attending the Last Post at the Menin Gate.

Note: in early 2023 Commonwealth War Graves Commission will start the restoration of the Menin Gate. This is expected to take approximately 18 months to complete. The Menin Gate Memorial will not be fully accessible to visitors during renovations. The daily Last Post service at 8pm will still take place but its location will sometimes be moved to an alternative location near the Menin Gate.
