Day **20** Ouarzazate Kasbah of Ait Ben Haddou Marrakech

Depart to the **Kasbah Taourirt**. A partially restored historic fortified residence complex. The Kasbah Taourirt was home to Thami El Glaoui, a pasha of Marrakesh during the 20th century. We continue to the **Kasbah of Ait Ben Haddou** designated a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Built in adobe and sloping down the hill. This photogenic city has been used in celluloid masterpieces like Orson Welles' "*Sodom and Gomorrah*" and the blockbuster *The Jewel of the Nile*.

Depart towards **Marrakech**, Southern Moroccan Capital, and located within an extensive oasis between the Atlas Mountains and the pre-desert area.

Tonight you will enjoy dinner at your hotel.

Overnight stay in Marrakech at the 5-star **Kenzi Rose**.

Day **21** Marrakech

Enjoy your daily breakfast at the hotel.

Join a city discovery tour, including the **Koutoubia Tower**, twin tower of the Giralda in Seville, **Saadines Tombs** and **Bay Palace**. Walk around the medina, souks and the magic Jma El Fna Square, which is packed with fortune tellers, snake tamers, acrobats, dancers, all making the center of the city an open-air theatre that requires the participation of the audience.

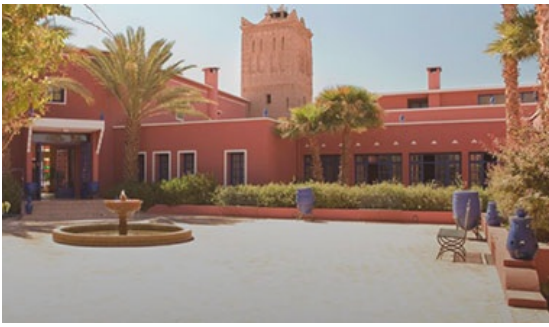
