On the second day, following breakfast, guests will embark on a journey by coach to explore Cadiz, affectionately known as the "Tacita de Plata" and renowned as one of the oldest cities in the Western world. Guests will have the opportunity to visit and immerse themselves in the charm of Cadiz, with some free time to explore at leisure. Lunch at a local restaurant in Sanlúcar de Barrameda, followed by a visit to a traditional wine cellar.

In the afternoon, return to Jerez. Enjoy some free time before dinner and an overnight stay onboard the train in Jerez

	After enjoying breakfast on board, you'll begin your exploration in Cordoba with a visit to the Mosque-Cathedral. Continuing
	your journey, we'll delve into the history of the former capital of the emirate and the medieval caliphate of Al Andalus, which at its peak became the largest, most cultured, and opulent city in Western Europe.
	Lunch at a local restaurant. Later, visit the historic city of Úbeda, recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Tour a traditional olive oil mill to learn about the production process.
	In the evening, enjoy dinner on board as the train arrives in Granada. Overnight stay in Granada.

The Al Ándalus Train offers two types of accommodation:

The Grand-Class Room: A cosy room with a private bathroom.
