Quebec City - Ottawa

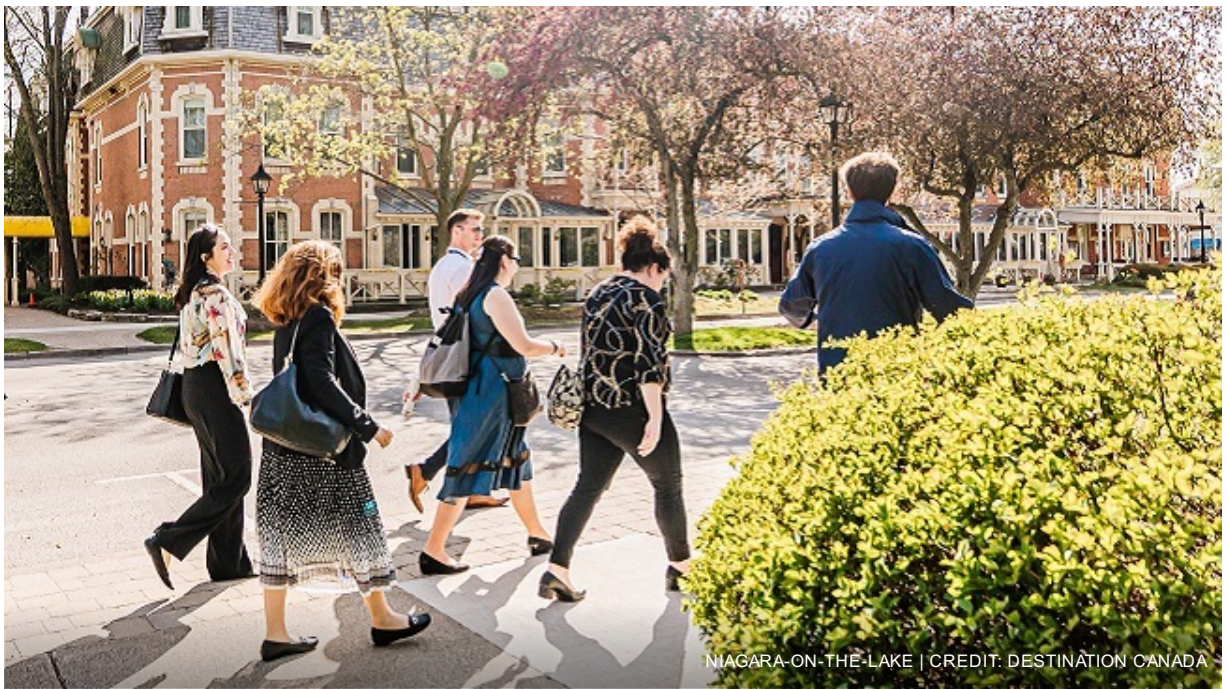


Day 11 Niagara Falls Toronto
